At the close of the program guests were served punch, coffee and cake. The evening closed with a party held at the home of Mike Goode in Timber Cove.

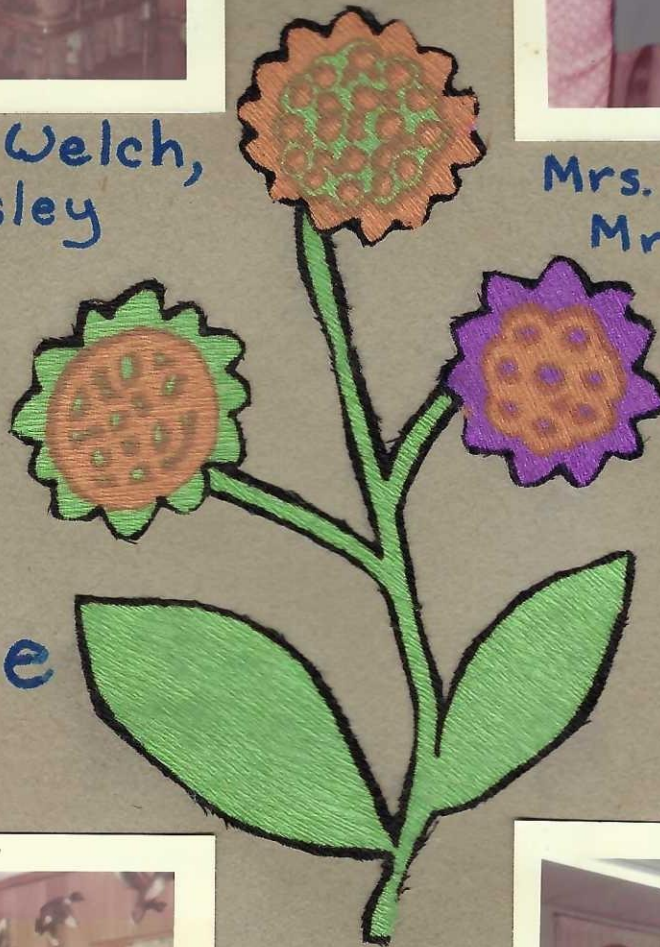
